

Pendergast School formed a Speak Up, Stand Up, Save a Life Club after the conference. The club is made up of 15 total 7th and 8th grade students. Students met throughout the year to determine how best to present and share the “Stand Up” message they received at the conference to all 860 students at Pendergast School. They were determined to personalize the message to each age range that they met with. The group discussed various ideas and decided on performing at 3 whole-school assemblies. The Club wrote and produced 2 different plays to perform. They also created an iMovie that outlines strategies to stand up to bullies for our upper grade students that can be re-viewed each year. The assemblies were interactive with audience members’ asking/answering questions, with our lower grades making a documented promise to stand up to bullies.

Next year we plan to continue the group, starting with our returning students and opening it to new students. The group brainstormed strategies that would be affective in combatting bullying and sharing the message of Stand Up, Speak Up, Save a Life, #GetInTheWay. Some of these ideas include:

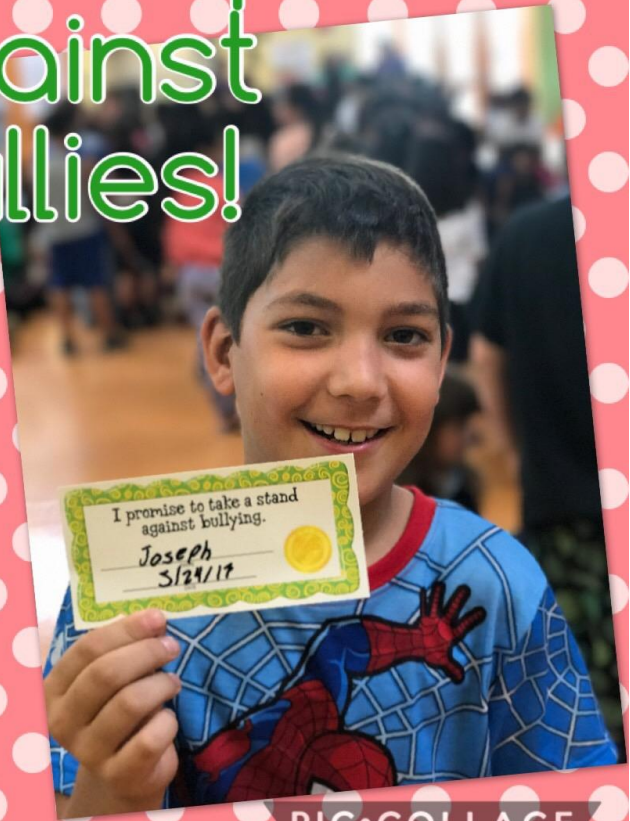
- Parent meetings
